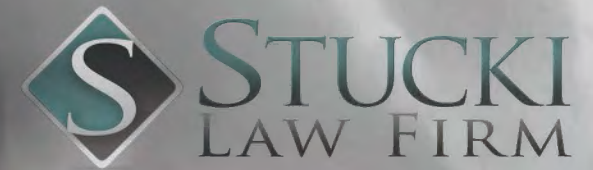

## Marital Settlement Agreement

A primary goal in divorce mediation is to develop a Marital Settlement Agreement. This is a legally binding agreement between couples that defines the terms of their divorce. Agreements typically include: how to divide the property and debt, child and/or spousal support (alimony), and custody and visitation plans.

Coming to an agreement means that costly attorneys will not be needed to litigate in a lengthy court process. Judges look very favorably on mediated agreements and issue a final decree that incorporates the Marital Settlement Agreement as the terms of divorce and custody.

## Mediation

We will meet with you and your spouse for two to four sessions depending on your situation. Each session lasts around 2 hours.

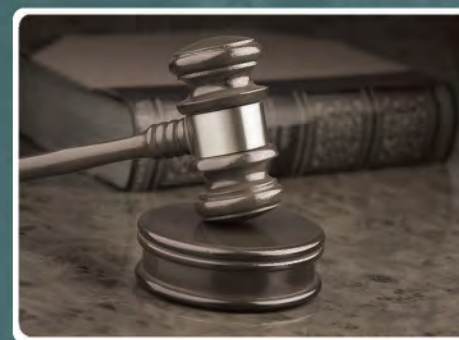
We will work to develop a Marital Settlement Agreement (MSA). The MSA may include agreements on: child custody and visitation, child support, spousal support (alimony), division of property and debt, and almost any other issue.

## Final Divorce

After we have developed your Marital Settlement Agreement, The Gentle Divorce can prepare the remainder of the legal forms, provide service of process, and notarize your documents.

We can then file the documents directly with the court, a judge will review the documents, and issue a final divorce decree based on the terms of your mediated agreements.
